SafeBoosC Finishes Recruitment

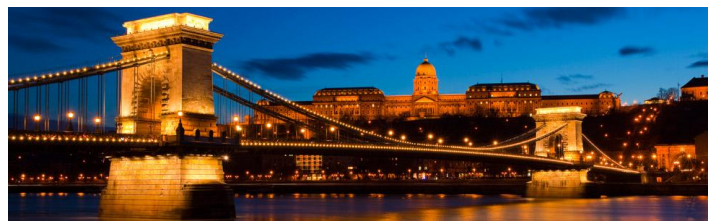
